The commitments below enable us to work together to seek gospel justice through the local church.

ADMINISTER JUSTICE COMMITS TO:

- > Provide materials to guide you in finding a Justice Champion and recruiting volunteers.
- > Present the model to the church (virtually) if requested.
- > Train and support all center volunteers.
- > Answer questions within 24 hours.
- > Provide materials for promoting the center once it is active.
- > Provide client feedback to the Justice Champion.
- > Feature your center on our Get Help page.
- > Maintain a webpage for client booking and linkable to/from your church website.

OUR CHURCH COMMITS TO:

- > Find a Justice Champion who will lead the center.
- > Have the designated church rep named below attend the Grand Opening.
- > Provide space (usually a private room plus a lobby for welcoming people) once a month for four hours, often a Saturday morning from 8:30 – 12:30.
- > Provide access to wifi and a printer if available.
- > Promote the center within the congregation once active.
